- Plan is to scale based on survey by Civil Site Group 1/9/18
- Lower retaining planter to be removed, pavers salvaged and reused to extend existing lower retaining wall along deck
- All existing lawn to be removed
- All existing steel edging to be removed
- Granite panels/ existing "fence" to be salvaged and to become series of "quarter turns" stairs. See details
- Granite chips to be retained and moved to desired location according to plan including "natural" paths & fire pit area
- Waterfall details TBD. Current design shows a 2-tiered "curtain falls"
- Areas shown with red dashed line to indicate bermed areas @ a max of 3'. Locations approximate and hand grading not to exceed 3'

WESTERN MEADOW

- Grass
- (20%) *Carex sprengei* (planted more under trees)
 - (20%) *Sporobolus heterolepis* (planted more along driveway)
 - (15%) *Sesleria autumnalis*
- Forbs
- (15%) (ephemeral) *Dodecatheon meadia* Midland Shooting Star (throughout)
 - (10%) *Asclepias tuberosa* Butterfly Flower (more along driveway)
 - (10%) *Lupinus perennis* Wild Lupine (driveway)
 - (15%) *Echinacea angustifolia* Narrow-leaved Coneflower (throughout)

MEADOW (60%-40% grass/forbs)

- Grass
- (8%) *Koeleria macrantha* June Grass
 - (10%) *Bouteloua gracilis* Blue Grama
 - (30%) *Sporobolus heterolepis* Prairie Drop (dominant grass species)
 - (10%) *Sesleria autumnalis* Autumn Moor Grass
- Forbs
- (6%) *Anemone patens* wolfgangiana Pasque Flower
 - (8%) *Lupinus perennis* Wild Lupine
 - (6%) *Asclepias tuberosa* Butterfly Flower
 - (8%) *Echinacea angustifolia* Narrow-leaved Coneflower
 - (8%) *Amorpha canescens* Lead Plant
 - (6%) *Liatris cylindracea* Dwarf Blazing Star

- *Carex rosea* Curly Styled Wood Sedge
- *Onoclea sensibilis* Sensitive Fern
- *Callitha palustris* Marsh Marigold
